

Understanding Contact Lens Examination Fees:

As a contact lens wearer, additional testing and follow up care is required to ensure your contacts fit properly and your vision is excellent. During this evaluation, the doctor will determine which contact and prescription in the best for your unique eyes.

There is a fee for your contacts to be evaluated and to obtain a contact lens prescription. This fee can range from \$70 to \$899 and is determined by your doctor based on the complexity of your prescription and the condition of your eyes. Since your eyes may change from year to year, it is important to re-evaluate your contact lenses each year to ensure your vision and eye health are the best they can be.

Same day cash pay and VSP insurance patients will receive a 15% discount, Eyemed insurance patients will receive a 10% discount.
